Instructions: Welcome to your summer assignment for AP/IB European History. This handout will walk you through the requirements for the summer work that must be completed and also afford you the opportunity to earn some extra credit for the coming school year.

Assignments:

1. You must complete taking notes on chapter 11 of the Spielvogel text. This will be due on the second full day of school and must be *hand written*. No submission will be accepted that are typed as it is far too easy to pirate them off the internet. On that day you will take a test over chapter 11. AP and IB will be given a Multiple Choice and LEQ (Essay) for the test.
2. Complete one Book and Film Review You are required to complete one of each.
 - a. Book/Film requirements- Write a minimum of a 500-word review ONLY if you have completed the text. Use of SPARK Notes or any other form of condensed summary is strictly forbidden. In the first paragraph you must use a quote from the book/film that you thought to be interesting and discuss it. Then use the remainder of the paper to critique the book/film and rate it on a scale of 1 to 5 stars (*****= Awesome, * = painful experience that I would not recommend)
 - b. In the remaining paragraphs, choose three specific facts (or people) that you felt were important to understanding the story and analyze them, react to them, and discuss.
 - c. What do I review? Choose any book that is pertinent to European history. I would choose something that you find intriguing as it will fuel your desire to learn about the course. If you are struggling to find something please come to see me and I can offer some suggestions.
 - d. **BONUS:** *Here is the **BONUS** part, if you desire, you may complete a book review for extra credit that will be applied to your grade.*
3. All book reviews must be submitted to turnitin.com, which I shall create on the first day of school at which time I will pass out the directions/codes to enroll in the class. Test on Chapter 11 will be the second full day of school.
4. All work concerning either book or film reviews will be submitted using www.turnitin.com. If you questions please see me before you leave for the summer. You may also contact me at kelly_p@shaker.org.
