### III. Graduation and College Admissions Testing

For the past five years, a greater proportion of Shaker Heights City School District students than Ohio students graduated (Table 61, p. 71). Conversely, the dropout rate was lower for Shaker students.

Note: SAT I and ACT tests are taken by students who are college bound and are applying to schools that require one or both tests. Therefore, the test results reported here for Shaker Heights, Ohio, and the nation should not be considered representative of all students. Furthermore, year-to-year differences in students' college plans can cause year-to-year score differences that are due to changes in the test-taking population rather than cohort-to-cohort changes in ability or achievement.

## College Admissions Tests (Tables 62-63, p. 72-73)

- For each of the past four years, mean SAT I scores for students in Ohio exceeded the means for the nation on the Verbal and Math tests, and the mean scores for students in the Shaker Heights City School District exceeded the means for the state.
- The mean math SAT I scores for all students in the Shaker Heights City School class of 2005 increased compared to the classes of 2002, 2003, and 2004. Mean verbal scores were slightly lower compared to the class of 2004.
- Data broken out by race/ethnicity show annual increases in verbal and math performance for Shaker African-American students since 2002. Math and verbal performance for Shaker European-American students in the class of 2005 returned to a level similar to their peers in the class of 2003.
- Shaker students from the class of 2005 who took the ACT outperformed Ohio students and students in the nation.
- ACT scores for African-American students increased in math and science and remained stable in English and reading from 2004 to 2005; those for European-American students decreased in English, math, and science and remained stable in reading.
