**Girls & Boys Nights Out:** On separate nights, 4<sup>th</sup> grade boys and girls and an adult chaperone (of the same gender) will meet with our school nurse, Ms. Exum, and a pediatrician to discuss changes boys & girls experience as they mature.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade Students Visit Woodbury School, 9:30-11:45 a.m.** This is an orientation visit (a presentation and a tour) for all Lomond 4<sup>th</sup> graders.

**Lomond Spring Open House & 4<sup>th</sup> Grade Art Show:** Come and check out all the wonderful things your student has been doing this year in the classroom, PE, Library, Mandarin, Music & Art. Show your student how proud you are of their hard work!

**Woodbury Band and Orchestra Instrument Try-Outs:** All Woodbury students must take instrumental music beginning in 5<sup>th</sup> grade. Before selecting an instrument, the Woodbury music teachers come to Lomond to let the students 'try-out' various instruments to see which ones they have the best aptitude for and interest in. After this 'try-out' session, you will receive a letter with recommendations for your child's 5<sup>th</sup> grade instrument. Be sure to complete, sign and return this form to your child's teacher.

**Mother-Son Brunch:** This all-school event is a great way to celebrate Mother's Day!

**Laps for Lomond:** This 'fun' draiser is a favorite for our students and parents. How many laps will your student run? Parents are very welcome to attend and cheer on their child and his/her classmates.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade IB Exhibition & Musical Performance, 4:30 p.m.** The IB Exhibition is the culminating IB project for the 4<sup>th</sup> grade students. Fourth graders have been working hard on a group topic of their choosing which they will present several times to friends and family. Students remain after school to have a snack and prepare. Students should wear shorts or skirt and a nice top. Parents should arrive in time for the first presentation which begins at 4:30 sharp. Don't miss it!

**Chalk Fest:** Students come outdoors by grade to decorate our school sidewalks with their drawings.

**Ice Cream Social:** Lomond's PTO organizes this fun, year-end event on the school Blacktop. A great way to celebrate a year of learning and community!

**Field Day:** This fun, healthy activity happens every year at Lomond School. Parent volunteers, led by Mr. Wagner, facilitate outdoor games for the entire school. 4<sup>th</sup> Grade participates in the afternoon.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade Memory Book Signing:** 4<sup>th</sup> grade students get together to sign each other's Memory Books.

**4<sup>th</sup> Grade Clap-Out 2:30 p.m.** Clap-Out is the Shaker Schools' tradition when a student moves on from their K-4 elementary school. 4<sup>th</sup> Graders walk through the school, cheered on by Lomond students in grades K-3. The 4<sup>th</sup> Graders are then announced at the front door, one at a time, where they exit, and are greeted by their teacher, the Principal and Staff Assistant, before crossing a bridge. The classes come out in alphabetical order: Mrs. Devine/Mrs. DiPiero, Ms. Hammer, Ms. Malone, Dr. Patterson. Clap-Out usually ends by 3:00pm.
