Concert Dress for all students will be ...

- **Girls:** White shirt, dark pants or knee-length skirt (leggings may be added underneath), and black shoes.
- **Boys:** White shirt, dark pants, black shoes, and a tie (bow ties included).

5th Grade Concert I: Thursday, December 8th – Shaker Middle School Auditorium

- 6:45 p.m. – The concert begins.
- Approximately 7:15 p.m. – The concert concludes and preparations begin for Concert II.

- **Call time:** 7:30 p.m. – All students should meet in the designated areas (band room, choir room...) for attendance and warm-up. Signs will be posted to direct students to the appropriate rooms. Please be sure to check in with one of the directors or other assistants when you arrive.
- 8:00 p.m. – The concert begins.
- Approximately 8:30 p.m. – The concert concludes.
