- Call time: 7:30 p.m. All students should meet in the designated areas (band room, choir room...) for attendance and warm-up. Signs will be posted to direct students to the appropriate rooms. Please be sure to check in with one of the directors or other assistants when you arrive.
- 8:00 p.m. The concert begins.
- Approximately 8:30 p.m. The concert concludes.
