FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Who can receive the Educator Emeritus designation?

Shaker educators may apply to receive this designation after *one year* of retirement. In order to be named an Educator Emeritus, the individual must have completed at least twenty years of service in education, the last ten of them in the Shaker Heights schools. Selected individuals will have displayed the high level of professionalism that characterizes Shaker educators. Specific contributions to the District will be taken into consideration by the Superintendent or designee when granting Educator Emeritus status.

What is expected of selected Educators Emeriti?

All Educators Emeriti are expected to participate in at least one school activity or event during the first year of service, and beyond as possible. The type of service can take many forms, including: volunteering as a guest classroom speaker or chaperone, attending sporting or social events, for example.

What are the benefits of participating in the Educator Emeritus program?

Educators emeriti will be formally recognized by announcements in the SHTA newsletter, retired Shaker teacher's newsletter, the District website, and other communications to current and retiring educators. The designation of Educator Emeritus may be useful in professional activities, or membership in community organizations.

Each emeritus may be asked to submit professional activities annually for publication in District materials.

Participants will also have a District e-mail account, business cards and ID badge.

How will Educators Emeriti be assigned?

Each educator will be associated with the building in which he or she worked. However, Educators Emeriti will be recognized as members of the Shaker schools community throughout all buildings.

What is the application process?

Individuals wishing to nominate themselves or a peer for the position of Educator Emeritus may request an application from the Shaker Heights Board of Education:
