## Hallway Behavior Expectations

To ensure Shaker Heights High School remains a safe and welcoming space for all of our students, staff, and guests, we will work together as a school community to establish and enforce appropriate hallway behavior throughout our building--before, during, and after school.

Per pages 44-45 of our Student Handbook, students who choose to stay on campus should be involved in meaningful activity that does not disrupt learning for other students. Students must have a hall pass when leaving a regularly scheduled class, mandatory activity, library, or office. Students should not loiter in the halls, entrances to the building, or other teaching areas during any period in the day, nor after school. This includes the campus areas and residential neighborhood adjacent to the school. During periods 1 through 10, students must report to the student gathering areas as designated by the administration. Closed corridors are to be observed by all students during all periods. Students using the campus are not to disrupt class activities.

Per page 53 of our Student Handbook, Students are expected to conduct themselves in a way that exhibits respect and consideration for the rights of others. Students of the District must conform with school regulations and accept directions from authorized school personnel. The Board has "zero tolerance" of violent, disruptive, harassing, intimidating, bullying, or any other inappropriate behavior by its students. A student who fails to comply with established school rules or with any reasonable request made by school personnel on school property and/or at school-related events is subject to approved student discipline regulations.

## <u>Gates</u>

To improve the safety and security of Shaker Heights High School, beginning this 4th Quarter, we will be closing certain gates in our hallways after school throughout the building. To ensure all students have access to their teachers for after-school conferences, the gates will be closed at 4:30pm each day. Between dismissal and 4:30pm, students are only expected to be in the building if they are attending conferences or participating in a sport or another student activity or organization. In all cases, students are expected to be in a specific location and supervised by a Shaker staff member. Students are not to be loitering or walking the halls of the building.

Students who are not attending conferences or involved in an after-school club or activity are expected to leave campus after dismissal. Depending on weather conditions, students may be permitted to remain in the Lower Cafeteria and/or on the outside patio that faces the Front Parking Lot. In all cases, students will be required to leave these locations no later than 5:00pm. Parents/Guardians are asked to ensure your child is picked up from school in a timely manner, as we cannot continue to provide supervision for our students after 5:00pm.

## Student IDs and Hall Sweeps

All students are expected to display their Student IDs at all times while on campus. This includes before, during, and after school, and especially while students are in the hallways. This is a safety and security measure. Any students staying after school for any reason may be required to show their ID to any Shaker staff member. Moving forward, the Administration and Security team at SHHS will begin conducting periodic hall sweeps during and after school. Students found in the hallways during a hall sweep are expected to (1) have their ID; (2) have a pass issued by a Shaker staff member; and (3) be in an authorized area that is related to the destination on their hall pass. Students failing to meet these expectations during the school day may be assigned discipline per our Student Handbook. After school, students failing to meet

these expectations may be assigned disciplinary consequences, and may be asked to leave campus.
